CRUCIFIXION OF JESUS

PROPHECY: BETRAYED FOR 30 PIECES OF SILVER

"Throw it to the potter," the Lord said to me—this magnificent price I was valued by them. So I took the thirty pieces of silver and threw it into the house of the Lord, to the potter.
